Zion's Church Council met on Monday March 4, 2024. Below is a summary:

Pastor Wes opened with devotion and prayer. We reviewed and approved the Secretary and Financial Income reports.

Preschool Director – Brandy Schneider

We currently have 53 students attending, 15 students signed up for the 2024/2025 school year, 14 are returning students and 1 is a sibling of a current student. Brandy Schneider and Erin Ragar attended the LCMS Early Childhood Conference on Saturday, March 2 at Immanuel Lutheran School in St. Charles, MO. The theme was Sparking Wonder Through STEAM. Brandy, Danika Spratt, Katie Martin, Amber Bounds, and Crystal Hudson will be attending the Conference on the Young Years in Osage Beach, MO this Friday and Saturday (March 8 and 9). The lead teachers are working with Brandy to find a new curriculum that better suits the needs of our students. The preschool is currently in need of new tables for 2 of the classrooms. 3 tables have been ordered, and three more tables will be ordered next year with approval of the budget.
